He advised the council that he would help them out in anyway he could to get the cemetery straighten out and once the land is surveyed and cleared he would come in and help get the lots mapped off.

- Councilwoman Bradley asked if everything was done with the cemetery being changed over to Pleasant Grove Church. Langford and Associates is still performing the survey so it is not completed at this moment. The mowing of Pleasant Grove is a concern and Councilwoman Bradley wanted to know what the city was going to do about this. The person that was keeping the grass mowed has went up on his fee. She only has maybe four churches donating now and that will not be enough to cover the cost. She asked what was the city going to do and the mayor said he would look into getting a price. There were also some concerns about Mr. Melvin Prince allowing someone to be buried in the wrong spot. The mayor advised that this matter would be fixed in a couple of days.
- Councilman Short-asked for an update on the Sammons Lot.
- Councilman Curry noted that he has had the park sprayed at his expense.
- Councilman Henderson noted that the community spring cleaning was a good idea and is going well.
- Mayor Weathersby that there are some concerns about four wheelers but it is a state law that they are not to be driven on city or county streets. This is a law that the city can't change and the city will abide by the laws. If there is a way that the city can allow them on the road the city will make them street legal. That means they will have to a tag, insurance and the driver will have to be licensed. Officer Moran stated that it was HB 121 and she would be enforcing the law on it. Golf Carts are ok but the rules and regulations for those will be enforced also. Her friend Garrott also spoke out on the laws and rules of the road. He stated that they have reclassified them so they will have to have the same regulations as a car.
