- Clerks Report- getting ready to file F.I.F.A. on delinquent taxes. The chief of police will be given a list of delinquent licenses of the local businesses. I have been put on FMLA and will only be working 2 whole days per week the other days will be listed as part-time. I will continue to make sure everything is done that needs to be done. I just won't physically be in the office. When the pressure from the well made several pipes bust the city had to file an insurance claim to get those paid. It was roughly 10-12 houses with minimal damage.

- **Police Report-** advised on the reports and what was done on the monthly printout. There has been some traffic stops and a few domestic calls.

- **Councilwoman Bradley** asked if everything was done with the cemetery being changed over to Pleasant Grove Church. Langford and Associates is still performing the survey so it is not completed at this moment. There were volunteers helping clean up the cemetery. As of right now Mr. Bobby Davis is cutting the grass and keeping it clean without being paid until there are funds to do so.
- **Councilman Short**-asked for an update on the Sammons Lot.

- **Mayor Weathersby** announced that June Fest will be hosted again this year by Angela Blackmon and she has asked if the city would donate. Councilman Short made the motion to donate \$500 like we have always done in the past. Councilman Curry seconded the motion and the motion passed with everyone agreeing. There has been an issue with Jay Street. The street is in between two homes located on Pearl Street. This street isn't being used as a public road so the mayor asked the council would it be ok to do away with it and let each land owner on each side of it split the cost to get it deeded over to them and close the road off. Councilman Short made the motion to let this be done and councilman Henderson seconded. **Motion Passed**
- **Garrett Moyer** was on the agenda to discuss public safety. He mentioned code of conduct he asked questions about the pending investigation. He was told that it was not completed. He asked the mayor why wasn't anything in the Chief's file about when he called in for him speeding through Sasser going 95 miles per hour on January 29. The mayor responded with he was verbally reprimanded. He also asked about the side by sides again. Stating that Georgia Law 40-6-10 states you shall arrest anyone that doesn't abide by this law.
- **Edrick Hardwich** was on the agenda to see if the council would allow him to have a yard party on Chaney Street. This was tabled until he was able to get more information about the time and keeping the noise level down.
